The latest confirmed status at the Ishikawa Factory (Wakabadai, Shika-town, Hakui-gun), which is close to the epicenter, is as follows.

1. About restarting production

After confirming the damage to the factory, we are currently undertaking restoration work with the goal of quickly resuming production. We aim to resume production of MT Ferrule, a component for multifiber optical connector, by the end of February.

We have received a lot of support and words of sympathy from our business partners. I would like to take this opportunity to express my deepest gratitude, thank you very much.

We will do our best to resume production as soon as possible and respond to your expectations, so we appreciate your continued understanding and support.
