The latest confirmed status at the Ishikawa Factory (Wakabadai, Shika-town, Hakui-gun), which is close to the epicenter, is as follows.

1. Completion of factory repair work

We are pleased to report that as of the end of March 2024, repair work on all areas of the factory that were damaged by the earthquake has been completed.

Production of MT Ferrule had already resumed as of the end of February, and production of other information and communication products has also resumed.

All products whose production was affected by the earthquake (see post below) are now in production again.
